We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the parties. Notices were issued to 1403 persons who were challaned either for violating of the directions of the Tribunal in relation to construction activity or for burning of municipal solid waste and other waste in the open. Out of these 270 or so among the Noticees have appeared and out of them 71 have already paid environmental compensation that has been imposed under the order of the Tribunal. As stated by the Corporation, they have received Rs. 63,50,000/- on that account. The remaining Noticees who have not been served, should be issued fresh Notice by the Municipal Corporation and they be directed to appear before the Tribunal on 10th March, 2017. The Noticees who have been served and are present before the Tribunal are granted two weeks time to pay environmental compensation in terms of the order of the Tribunal to the Item No. 32 to 38

concerned Municipal Corporation. In the event they fail to pay compensation within two weeks from today the same shall be recovered from the Noticees as arrear of land revenue in terms of the Civil Procedure Code and laws in force by the concerned S.D.M. of the respective areas.
